

Current VA Disability Ratings & Historical COLA's

VA disability compensation or VA disability pay is scheduled to increase by 3.2% effective 1 December 2023. You will see the pay rate increase in your January VA disability compensation payment.

This table shows the 2024 and 2023 VA Service-Connected Disability Compensation Rates (Veteran Only), no spouse, children, or parents as dependents.

If you have a 10% to 20% VA disability rating, you will not receive a higher rate even if you have a dependent spouse, child, or parent.
